CLL

Children will develop skills such as being able to maintain their attention for longer periods, following a story without pictures or prompts, listen, and respond to ideas from others in conversation. Children will be learning key vocabulary each week linked to the text they are reading. They will learn how to use this language in context and use it in their play.

PSED

To support children with managing feelings and behaviour, children will learn about rules and boundaries in our school but also community. To develop self-confidence and self-awareness children will be thinking about what they are good at and what they enjoy doing. Children will have lots of opportunities to develop confidence through small group learning opportunities.

PD

To support the development of health and self-care skills, children will learn about staying safe and healthy. This will involve learning how to stay safe online, by water, in the house, in the sun and crossing roads safely.

Curriculum enrichment
