

CLL

Children will build on listening and attention skills in different contexts for example by starting to attend school assemblies and listening to stories in whole class contexts. Children will be learning how to answer 'why' and 'how' questions. Children will be learning to retell traditional tales using actions, repetitive language and story maps developing their speaking skills.

PSED

Children will be supported to develop skills in order to solve conflicts and make compromises. Children will apply their understanding of these skills by solving simple moral dilemmas such as 'Does the fox in the Gingerbread man do the wrong thing?'

PD

Children will learn about making healthy choices in relation to food, hygiene and exercise for example keeping germs away by washing hands after sneezing and before eating and the importance of regular exercise. Children will learn about keeping themselves safe and stranger danger.

Curriculum enrichment

Classroom environment changed regularly (a kitchen, a trolls cave, three little pig's construction site, grandma's cottage.)

Literacy

In Literacy, children will be learning about a range of traditional tales. They will be learning to make simple predictions, describe characters and describe settings. Children will learn how to write captions and short simple sentences.

Mathematics

In mathematics, children will learn to use vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting. They will learn to solve simple addition and subtraction problems. Children will learn simple vocabulary related to money and will solve simple problems using this understanding. Children will build upon their understanding of shape by exploring 3D shapes and will learn to name some.

EAD

In Expressive Arts and Design, children will be learning techniques to shape, assemble and join materials. Children will learn a range of songs linked to traditional tales. They will learn about sounds different instruments make. Children will also learn simple dances and create their own songs.

UTW

Children will be learning about, and observing objects that float and sink. They will learn to use observational skills such as looking at similarities, differences, patterns and change. Children will be learning to use a range of technology for example programming bee bots to move. Children will be learning about materials and will learn how to carry out simple tests on them. Children will also be learning about the celebration of Easter.
