



CLL

Children will build on their communication skills in different contexts. Learning will become a little more structured and when children complete tasks they will be encouraged to become more independent and collaborating with others on their table. Children will be learning and expected to use a range of vocabulary based on growing and changing.

PSED

Children will develop empathy skills by talking about characters feelings in stories. Children will be given opportunities to express their opinions and feelings about different scenarios. They will also learn about the importance of respecting other people's opinions.

PD

Children will learn about making healthy choices in relation to food and will learn about different food groups. Children will learn about a balanced diet and create their own meals.

Literacy

In Literacy, children will be learning about a range of fiction stories. Children will sequence stories and will then begin to write simple stories. They will also be learning about instructions and will create their own set of instructions. Children will be learning how to spell more tricky words correctly.

Mathematics

In mathematics children will build upon their measurement understanding by measuring length, height, capacity and weight in non-standard units. Children will be learning about sharing, halving and doubling and will solve problems involving these skills. Children will also be learning about time (days of the week, times of the day, key vocabulary such as minutes, hours, seconds).

EAD

In Expressive Arts and Design, children will be learning a range of techniques such as sketching to create an observational drawing. Children will be learning how to use a range of tools and materials safely to plan, create and evaluate their own farm scene.

UTW

Children will be learning about growing plants. They will explore what a plant needs to grow and how it changes over time. Children will learn about animals and their young. They will also make observations about how animals grow and change over time. Children will learn more about their local environment and compare it to other environments.
