

Geography

The children will learn about human and physical features across Greece. Using a range of maps the children will identify features across Greece and the wider world.

History

The children will learn about Ancient Greek history with a focus on investigating culture, society and warfare.

RE

The children will Use an increasingly wide religious vocabulary to explain the impact of key events on individuals and communities. They will describe why Easter is so important to Christians

PSHE

The children will learn about developing healthy relationships with friends and the importance of understanding safe relationships. Children will explore strategies to recognise the importance of self-respect

MFL

The children will learn about key language used within a café. Children will focus on tenses and verbs related to ordering food and relational vocabulary.

Curriculum enrichment

The children will be immersed in Ancient Greek life throughout learning opportunities across the curriculum. In addition, we will have a Science day to further enhance children's understanding of their topic this term. Children will experiment with a range of different enquiries to build on their existing knowledge.



Science

The children will give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials, including metals, wood and plastic. They will demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes. Children will explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials, and that this kind of change is not usually reversible, including changes associated with burning and the action of acid on bicarbonate of soda.

Computing

The children will continue to learn about E-Safety. In addition, the children will investigate how to create an advertisement using green screen technology.

Design and Technology

The children will learn about sewing and stitching. Using their own research, the children will create their own Greek styled sandal. They will evaluate their own ideas and products and select from a wider range of materials and components (textiles) according to functional properties and aesthetic qualities.

Art and Design

The children will learn about Ancient Greek sculptures with a focus on sculptures of heads. The children will build up techniques to create and mould their own sculpture with a Greek mythological theme.

PE

The children will learn about Cricket, Futsall and Netball and which skills are needed to play. The children will build upon their leadership skills along with developing competence in how to stay active for a sustainable period.
