CLL

Children will develop skills such as being able to maintain their attention for longer periods, following a story without pictures or prompts, listen, and respond to ideas from others in conversation. Children will be introduced key vocabulary each week linked to the text they are reading. They will learn how to use this language in context and use it in their play.



To support children with managing feelings and behaviour, children will learn about rules and boundaries in our school but also community. To develop self-confidence and self-awareness children will be thinking about what they are good at and what they enjoy doing. Within a family group or class bubble children need to be given lots of opportunities to develop confidence through learning opportunities.

PD

To support the development of health and self-care skills, children will learn about staying safe and healthy. This will involve learning how to stay safe online, by water, in the house, in the sun and crossing roads safely.

There will also be many opportunities for walks and

developing physical skills outdoors.

Spring Term Superheroes

Literacy

In Literacy, children will be learning about the features of a book for example title, blurb and illustrations. They will develop prediction skills. Children will be learning how to write words using the sounds they know. They will then use this skill to write labels, short captions and move towards simple sentence writing.

Mathematics

In mathematics children will be learning recognise numerals 1-5, moving on to 10. They will learn how to order and compare numbers. Children will be developing their understanding of measurement. They will order and compare lengths and move on to measuring length in non-standard units.

EAD

In Expressive Arts and Design, children will be learning techniques to shape, assemble and join materials. Children will use these techniques to build an emergency service vehicle.

Children will also learn a range of 'people who help us' nursery rhymes and songs. They will also learn actions to go with the songs. They will use instruments (that they have made) to make music.

<u>UTW</u>

Children will be learning about different people in our community such as fire fighters, police officers, paramedics and vets.

Children will learn how and why people celebrate Chinese New Year.
